ITINERARY

How to reach Vanbreda?

By train

- leave the railway station Antwerpen-Berchem through the main exit
- cross the square and take the street in front of you, in the far left corner (Cogels-Osylei)
- after the railway bridge, take the first street at your right
- follow the street (pass the roundabout) until the traffic lights: you will see our office across the street.

By car

coming from Ghent, Brussels or The Netherlands

- on the Antwerp Ring, take exit n° 3 (Borgerhout) to the centre
- at the second traffic lights after the railway bridge, you will see our office on your right hand side.

coming from Liège or Turnhout

- at the end of the E313/E34, take the exit Antwerpen (exit on the left hand side)
- turn left at the end of the exit (traffic lights), on to De Singel
- turn right at the second traffic lights
- at the second traffic lights, you will see our office on your right hand side.
